CALL TO ORDER – Mayor Nolan S. Barham, Sr.

ROLL CALL

Roll was called by new City Recorder, Colleen Adams. All Council-members were present except Councilman M. A. Smitty.

Mayor Barham welcomed everyone in attendance to the meeting.

SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS

Representative Curt Cobb presented a \$5,000.00 grant check to Ronnie Hill for the Eagleville City Park and a \$10,000.00 grant check to the Eagleville Linebaugh Library from Community Enhancement grants.

Sgt. James Faurie from the Eagleville High School JROTC invited all Councilmembers and residents to the Veterans Day Program May 26, 2008 at 10:00 am. The JROTC will be it hosting at the Eagleville City Park where Daniel Wilson will be dedicating the statue.

CITIZEN INPUT

Resident David Turner thanked Representative Cobb for the Grant checks and invited him to attend a meeting left undetermined.

ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Councilman Harold Vincion moved to accept the agenda with Councilman Terry Zumbro seconding. After a vote taken by City Recorder Colleen Adams, the motion passed 4-0.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilman David Rigsby made a motion for the Approval of Minutes with Councilman Harold Vincion seconding. After a vote taken by City Recorder Colleen Adams, the motion passed 4-0.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Councilman Harold Vincion made a motion for the approval of the April 2008 Financial Report with Councilman Terry Zumbro seconding. After a vote taken by City Recorder Colleen Adams, the motion passed 4-0.

PARK UPDATE

Vice-Mayor Ronnie Hill stated that there have been a lot of ball games played at the park, and stated that the trophies have been ordered, but more sponsors were still needed for the upcoming Car Show. He also stated that they will be getting started on the walking trail soon, and the \$5,000.00 grant money they received will be put to that cause. The trail is expected to be complete by the fall.

OLD BUSINESS

Mayor Barham stated there was no update on the investigation.

City Attorney Adam Dodd presented the proposed Public Records Procedures Policy. He stated that the City is within reason to ask for an ID when they are requesting records for proof of residency, as records are only open to residents. Mr. Dodd also stated that the Deed has been signed by Mr. Sam Tune for the sale of the Shed on Allisona Road.

Mr. Dodd stated that a Trucking Company that was inquiring about locating in Eagleville on Cheatham Springs Road and that their attorney has withdrawn their appeal. Mr. Dodd also stated that the C2 Zoning of that property may need to be reviewed to ensure that there is no blanket omission for some businesses.

Mr. Dodd also stated he had received an inquiry regarding the sale of Beer in City limits, and wanted the Council Members to be aware of it. Mr. Dodd then introduced his associate Leigh Tudor.

Mayor Barham suggested a motion be made on the Revised Public Records Policy. Councilman Terry Zumbro made a motion with Councilman David Rigsby seconding. After a vote taken by City Recorder Colleen Adams, the motion passed 4-0.

NEW BUSINESS

City Recorder Colleen Adams stated that late notices had been sent out to residents showing unpaid taxes. She stated there had apparently been a little confusion regarding the detail that had been attached to payments from Mortgage Companies but it has since been resolved.

City Recorder Colleen Adams suggested to the City Council Members to eliminate the Payroll Ban Account. She stated this account was only being used for 1 person's payroll and the transferring of funds back and forth from General Funds was not necessary. Vice-Mayor Ronnie Hill made a motion to eliminate the Payroll Fund and have the City Recorders Pay come directly from the General Funds. Councilman David Rigsby seconded the motions and after a vote taken by City Recorder, Colleen Adams it passed 4-0.

Mayor Barham stated that he had received a request from former City Police Chief Everett Stone for the return of a Firearm he had purchased and used to trade in on another firearm when he was Chief for a keepsake. The firearm is currently at the Rutherford County Sheriff's office. City Attorney Adam Dodd agreed to research the liability of the City before a decision was made.

POLICE REPORT

FIRE REPORT

Fire Chief David Martin stated the fire calls were down, and the burn ban has been lifted, but wanted to remind everyone that burns still need to be attended. He also stated that they were called to a suspected gas leak the night before and that it was the first call in 21 days.

Mayor Barham stated he has made plans to make Safe Burning presentations to the 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th graders at Eagleville School.

CLOSING

Mayor Barham closed the meeting by thanking all for attending and stated that the 2008/2008 Budget was almost completed and a work session would be called soon. It was moved by Councilman Harold Vincion moved with Councilman Terry Zumbro seconding the motion. With unanimous vote the meeting ended at 7:58 pm.
