

ORDINANCE # 2017-004

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EAGLEVILLE, TENNESSEE,
AMENDING ORDINANCE 2016-003 THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
BEGINNING JULY 1, 2016 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2017.**

Whereas, *Tennessee Code Annotated* Title 9 Chapter 1 Section 116 requires that all funds of the State of Tennessee and all its political subdivisions shall first be appropriated before being expended and that only funds that are available shall be appropriated; and

Whereas, *Tennessee Code Annotated* Title 6 Chapter 56 Section 208 allows the City to amend the budget ordinance in the same manner as any other ordinance may be amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAGLEVILLE, TENNESSEE that Section 2 & 5 of Ordinance 2016-003 are hereby amended as follows:
