SEWER UPDATE

Mayor Tune stated that approximately 3 years ago the City Council voted to pursue the Membrane Bioreactor (MBR) system and that since there may be some difficulty obtaining a permit to operate the MBR system, the City may need to look at alternative systems. City Attorney Mr. Leon Sharber agreed with Mayor Tune that if the city is not going to pursue the MBR system, then the Council will need to vote to undo that motion and re-evaluate how to proceed.

NEW BUSINESS

John and Casey Lewis, owners of Stonegate Enterprises, have offered to donate landscaping for the front of the new City Hall building. Currently the front of City Hall is all covered with old broken asphalt; there are no dirt or landscape beds to allow for any plantings. This would also provide a good place for the Sons of the Confederate Soldiers monument that will be arriving sometime in July. After discussion and several amendments, the motion below was agreed upon.

Accept Donated Landscaping by Stonegate and create a budget not to exceed \$3,500 to dig up existing asphalt to create beds for landscape, pour concrete sidewalks, buy flag poles, and lettering, for the City Hall building. The Mayor and City Manager are to be empowered as managers for this project.

FY 2012-2013 Budget

City Manager William Haston presented the Council with the FY 2012-2013 budget that he had prepared. He stated that according to the Charter the Budget Ordinance is to be published within 3 days before it is taken up for consideration by the Council. That has not been happened, but he will have it published. He stated that the deadline for publication is Saturday, May 26th and he will have it published, so it will be ready for the 1st reading. Mr. Haston continued with an overview of the proposed city budget.

Upon conclusion, Mayor Tune conferred with Mr. Haston that Mr. Haston would get the notice in the paper in preparation for the council to schedule a called meeting for the budget's first reading. Following discussion it was decided to schedule a Budget Workshop for Tuesday, June 12th at 7:00 p.m. and a called Council meeting at 8:00 p.m. The Public Hearing and 3rd reading will be held at the Regular Council meeting on Thursday, June 28th, 2012. The 2nd reading date will be sometime between June 12th and the 28th. That date is to be set at a later time.
