**PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED ANNEXATION**

Planning Commission Chairman, Nick Duke, asked for public comments on proposed annexation for Mr. John E. Turner's property located at 1535 Highway 41A South; Tax Map 163, Parcel 008.00, 43.38 acres total; yet only approximately 28.7 acres are being proposed for annexation that includes 1000 feet off the eastern right-of-way boundary of Highway 41A South.

There were no public comments. Mayor Tune closed the Public Hearing at 7:16 p.m. and re-opened the Council Meeting.

Chief Parks stated statistics and reported that the Fire Dept. had begun training with the extrication equipment. He also noted that the fire hydrant near the Baptist Church building had been knocked over and that Consolidated Utility District had put it back into service.

**POLICE REPORT** – Elijah Stuard

Chief Stuard reported statistics for the last month and noted that he was present at the recent High School Graduation and that he and Reserve Officer Breniser would be a presence at as many of the ballgames as possible. With 2 officers now, the amount of calls to assist the County has more than doubled. He stated that there are less automobile wrecks than last year. Only 30-40% of those stopped by Eagleville officers actually receive citations. Their priority is to keep the streets safe.
