Mayor Tune mentioned that Ed Wettig has been working as a contract maintenance worker for the City of Eagleville for 14 years and Bob Weske for the past 4 years. Mayor Tune noted that he is exploring bringing these two contract labor maintenance workers on as part-time City employees.
