Jane Puckett – would like a status report on her two vacant lots. One held a building previously on it but was destroyed by fire. The debris from said fire subsequently also destroyed the septic tank on this property. There was insurance and she would like to rebuild but wants to know she will be getting sewer and a tank. Mayor Sam Tune said per previous council meetings, she would. Attorney Leon Sharber said he had been in contact with Mrs. Puckett's attorney. There is some concern from Mr. Herbert Crick who owns the property behind the Post Office, but is being researched.

Herbert Crick – would like the city to do something about the property on Poplar Street in Hill Crest. The condition of the property is degrading surrounding properties. Linda Dansby, City Codes Administrator informed there is a bid on the foreclosed property. She has been in contact with the person taking bid and he wishes to rectify as soon as possible. Mrs. Dansby is working with all parties to be sure this is taken care of.




