

**ORDINANCE 2024-001**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EAGLEVILLE, TENNESSEE TO AMEND  
ORDINANCE 2023-001, SAME BEING THE ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL  
BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2023 TO JUNE 30, 2024**

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF EAGLEVILLE, TENNESSEE,  
AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** That Ordinance 2023-001, same being the budget appropriation ordinance for the 2023-2024 fiscal year, be and the same is hereby amended by adding (subtracting) the amounts specified herein to certain revenue and expenditure appropriations as follows:

**GENERAL FUND**

**Revenues and Other Sources:**

From Projected Increase in Fund Balance - June 30, 2024 \$ 262,350

**Total Change in Revenues** **\$ 262,350**

**Expenditures and Other Uses:**

Transfer to Capital Projects Fund \$ 112,350

Transfer to Debt Service Fund \$ 80,000

Transfer to State Street Aid Fund \$ 70,000

**Total Change in Expenditures** **\$ 262,350**

**CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND**

**Revenues and Other Sources:**

Transfer from General Fund \$ 112,350

**Expenditures and Other Uses:**

General Government – City Hall & Bank Building Roof  
Repairs & Demolition of Pump House in FY 2024 \$ 20,350

Police Vehicle – For Purchase in FY 2026 \$ 67,000

Public Safety Center – Furnishings – FY 2025 \$ 5,000

Demolition of Old Police/Fire Building/Construction of  
Parking Lot - FY 2025 \$ 20,000

**Total** **\$ 112,350**

**DEBT SERVICE FUND**

**Revenues and Other Sources:**

Transfer from General Fund \$ 80,000

**Expenditures and Other Uses:**

Reserve/Cashflow for Future Annual Debt Service Payments \$ 80,000

**Total \$ 80,000**

**STATE STREET AID FUND**

**Revenues and Other Sources:**

Transfer from General Fund \$ 80,000

**Expenditures and Other Uses:**

For Road/Resurfacing Projects \$ 70,000


**Total \$ 70,000**

**SECTION 3.** That pursuant to T.C.A. Section 6-22-124 (C), sufficient unappropriated revenue is available in the General Fund to the increased appropriations proposed under Ordinance 2024-001.


**SECTION 4.** That this budget amendment fulfills the requirements of the Municipal Budget Law of 1982 (T.C.A Section 6-56-208).
