AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EAGLEVILLE, TENNESSEE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2022-001, SAME BEING THE ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2022 TO JUNE 30, 2023

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF EAGLEVILLE, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance 2022-001, same being the budget appropriation ordinance for the 2022-2023 fiscal year, be and the same is hereby amended by adding (subtracting) the amounts specified herein to certain revenue and expenditure appropriations as follows:

SECTION 4. That this budget amendment fulfills the requirements of the Municipal Budget Law of 1982 (T.C.A Section 6-56-208).

SECTION 5. Be it Ordained by the City of Eagleville, Tennessee that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, or fifteen days after it first passage, whichever occurs later, the public welfare requiring it.
