

RESOLUTION 2024-003

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EAGLEVILLE, TENNESSEE AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN NATIONAL PURCHASING COOPERATIVES TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES

WHEREAS, National Purchasing Cooperatives have been established as cooperative purchasing alliances that allow participating local governments to utilize competitively solicited purchase contracts, thereby benefitting from volume pricing while satisfying local bidding requirements; and

WHEREAS, *Tennessee Code Annotated* § 12-3-1205 authorizes municipalities to participate in purchasing cooperatives such as Omnia, Sourcewell, NPPGov and BuyBoard .

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF EAGLEVILLE, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That participation in National Purchasing Cooperatives is hereby authorized as an alternative or supplement to the competitive bid process, provided that all purchase through contracts shall otherwise follow the City's established purchasing procedures.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the City's participation in National Purchasing Cooperatives, subject to the approval of the City Attorney.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage, the general welfare of the City of Eagleville, Rutherford County, Tennessee requiring it.


